Roger Payne-stated the County owns the following roads that were deeded over: Circling Hawk, Pyramid Shadows and Mustang road, but the County has never taken over maintenance of these roads. This is about 6.2 miles of road maintenance. Eight families and one farm is out there and the maintenance is becoming an issue. Mr. Payne requests that the County provide maintenance grading on a regular schedule for this subdivision.

Jerri Davis- stated she would like to add to what Mr. Payne said--when hay season starts, the roads are beat to death. Anything the County can do would be greatly appreciated.

Meira Gault-inquired what is the difference between this subdivision and other subdivisions. Mr. Payne sated this subdivision was deeded to the County on the plat.

Beth Cox- stated the Elks is having a music show this weekend and has tickets and wants the Board to be in attendance.

New Mexico Department of Health Office was present

Dave Daniels-stated he is here to answer any questions the citizens of the County have questions about infectious diseases from migrants-it is up to hospitals to get reimbursed for services for these migrants

Margarita Diaz-has flyers that have information on migrants bringing infectious diseases to New Mexico and contact service information.

Bernadette Gutierrez-stated that the flu virus and various GI virus as well as illness' from traveling 2,000 miles on foot (trauma) to get here have been recorded by the hospitals. The flesh-eating bacteria that was reported in the media was false. The migrant is still hospitalized with other medical conditions.
