

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING AND ROAD VIEWING
HIDALGO COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS
PROPOSED VACATION OF PORTIONS OF CLOVERDALE ROAD AND FOSTER
DRAW ROAD**

Notice is hereby given that a commission of freeholders (committee) appointed by the Hidalgo County Board of County Commissioners will hold a public meeting and road viewing on **Friday, May 22, 2026, at 10:00 a.m.**, beginning at the **intersection of Geronimo Trail and County Road 1**, Hidalgo County, New Mexico.

The committee has been appointed to act as road viewers regarding the proposed vacation of portions of **Cloverdale Road and Foster Draw Road**.

The purpose of the meeting is for the road viewers to view the portions of Cloverdale Road and Foster Draw Road proposed for vacation, view the entirety of the proposed alternate route, and view San Luis Pass Road as an example of the type of improvements proposed for the alternate route. Members of the public wishing to do so may follow the road viewers during the viewing in their own personal vehicles.

Following completion of the road viewings, the viewers will reconvene in public session. At that time, members of the public will be permitted to share their concerns, comments, and views regarding the proposed road vacation and the proposed improvements to the alternate access. The road viewers may take those comments into account in preparing their written report and recommendation to the Hidalgo County Board of County Commissioners.
